This is not the case any longer. The majority of our patients have gotten addicted to prescription drugs such as: Codeine, Dilaudid, Heroin, Hydrocodone, Lortab, Lorcet, Percocet, Percodan, Morphine, Oxycodone, and Oxycotin. More so, whatever you have in your medicine cabinet will probably be the most likely suspect.
