

Transitional Housing Resources

The main goal of the transitional housing assistance programs are to help people get back on their feet and regain self-sufficiency. So to this end, the people who stay at the centers will be able to attend various classes and workshops. This can include budgeting classes, job training, and other life skills. In addition to the housing, other basic needs can be met and families will receive meals, clothing, including shelter, and also information on or access to transitional units. A number of other services are available to clients. If a transitional housing program can't meet your needs then ask for referrals.
